As the name suggests, this shall be a Hindi/English/Hinglish *Storytelling Face-off*.

Each club can either choose to conduct an internal face off or nominate a member. But we encourage you to organize a competition! Ideally this should be a 2-4 min speech.

Club Face-Off winner or ***Nominated*** member Name should be submitted through [this form](#) latest by 30 September by the **VP Education** only.

All members will then be randomly assigned to a group for the next stage i.e., Qualifying Round.

Qualifying round will be conducted in the month of October and the participants will be informed two weeks in advance. Here every member will be required to present a story in 2-4 mins each. This will be conducted online on Zoom platform.

Round 1: 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. IST

Round 2: 8:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. IST

There will be no disqualification based on time. The participant will be muted at the end of 4 mins and 30 seconds.

The top 2 from each group shall proceed to the ***Social Media Round***. This will be held in

January 2024.

What is the **Social Media Round**:

- The qualifying round video will be uploaded on #D98 social media handle
- Maximum likes will get you to the Finals list!

Top 6 will then proceed to the ***Finals***.

Finals will be held at Eloquence in person (no hybrid option) and here the time limit will be 5-7 mins.

Kahaani Judging Criteria

1. Concept (thought process, idea, originality, etc) - 10
2. Character Building (introduction, relevance, etc) - 15
3. Narrative (building the story line, curiosity, engaging the audience) - 30
4. Structure (clear beginning, middle, and end) - 15
5. Voice, Body and Props - 20
6. Climax (Twists & Turns) - 10
